Amendment #22 to the 2009 Federal Transportation Improvement

Program (FTIP) - Type 3 Formal Amendment

Recommendation

By Motion:

Recommend the Policy Board adopt by Resolution Amendment #22 (Type 3 Formal Amendment) to StanCOG's 2009 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP), and authorize StanCOG's Executive Director to make minor modifications to the 2009 FTIP as needed.

Background

As the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization, for the Stanislaus Region, StanCOG is responsible for managing state and federal funds through a document called the Federal Transportation Improvement Program, or FTIP. Adopted by the Policy Board on July 9, 2008, this document contains the entire list of transportation projects that state and federal funds have been awarded through StanCOG, CalTrans, or other grantor agencies for FFYs 08/09 - 11/12. Occasionally, this document must be amended to add new projects, modify project descriptions or funding amounts, change program-funding year, or delete existing projects.

Discussion Items

StanCOG is proposing a Formal Amendment #22 (Type 3) to the 2009 FTIP. The 2009 FTIP is the programming document that identifies four years (FY 08/09, FY 09/10, FY 10/11, and FY 11/12) of federal, state and local funding sources for projects in Stanislaus County. Draft Amendment #22 adds projects to, and modifies existing projects in the 2009 FTIP. The following items are attached as part of Amendment #22 for your review:

- Attachment #1 Project List & CTIPS Page summarizes programming changes resulting from Amendment #22 to the 2009 FTIP. Projects or project phases are consistent with the 2007 RTP which was adopted by the StanCOG Policy Board on May 9, 2007 and by FHWA/FTA on June 30, 2007
- Attachment #2 Financial Tables/Plan: Reflects FTA 5310 Elderly & Disabled Current FFY 09/10 Revenue \$4,293 & Current FFY 09/10 Programmed \$4,293.
 Reflects SHOPP Grouped Projects Safety Improvements Current FFY 10/11 Revenue \$2,705,000 & Current FFY 10/11 Programmed \$2,705,000.

Changes proposed by Amendment #22 to the StanCOG 2009 FTIP have been determined to be exempt from the requirement that an air conformity determination or regional emissions analysis be conducted per 40 CFR 93.126; .127; or .128. Exempt

projects require no additional conformity determination. Additionally, the projects presented in Amendment #22 do not interfere with the timely implementation of approved TCMs.

- The 2009 FTIP is a listing of capital improvement and operational expenditures utilizing federal and state monies for transportation projects in Stanislaus County during the next four years that are eligible to proceed without a conformity determination.
- The Draft Amendment #22 to the 2009 FTIP contains project phases, funding and/or projects that are not included in the 2009 TIP.
- The Draft Conformity Analysis contains the documentation to support a finding that the Draft Amendment #22 meets the air quality conformity requirements for carbon monoxide, ozone and particulate matter.
- This is a Type 3 Formal amendment to the 2009 FTIP
- The amendment is being circulated for comments a minimum of 14 days prior to approval.
- The proposed amendment does not interfere with the timely implementation of any approved Transportation Control Measures.
- The amendment maintains the financial constraint of the 2009 FTIP.
- This amendment will require full State and Federal concurrence and, accordingly, will be forwarded to the reviewing agencies after Policy Board action.
