The Draft 2019 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP) is now available for public review at the following website:

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) prepares the FSTIP every two years in cooperation with metropolitan planning organizations and regional transportation planning agencies in California. The FSTIP is a federally mandated document that includes phases of capital and non-capital transportation projects prioritized to receive federal funding under Titles 23 and 49 of the United States Code during federal fiscal years 2019 through 2022. It also includes regionally significant projects regardless of the funding source.
