- E. Motion to Authorize a Release of a Request for Proposal (RFP), Interview, Select, and Negotiate a Contract for the Transportation Development Act (TDA) Triennial Performance Audits
 - *By Motion (Member Luis Molina/Member Ed Katen), and a unanimous vote, the Policy Board approved Items 5A, 5B, 5D and 5E of the Consent Calendar.

6. PRESENTATION

A. John Muir Highway

Monty Thornburg provided information about the effort to rename part of State Route 132 to the John Muir Highway. Charles Turner offered comments in support of the effort. There was consensus to take the idea to the member agencies for resolutions and to then return to the Policy Board for a resolution. Member Van Winkle said the City of Waterford had already passed a resolution and that it would be provided to the member agencies.

A. Motion to Adopt Resolution 14-53 to Approve a Local Match for the San Joaquin Valley Goods Movement Sustainable Implementation Plan

Rosa Park indicated that a Caltrans grant had been received for a Valley-wide Goods Movement study and that StanCOG's portion of the match would be in staff time.

- *By Motion (Member Luis Molina/Member Tony Madrigal), and a unanimous vote, the Policy Board adopted Resolution 14-53 approving a local match for the San Joaquin Valley Goods Movement Sustainable Implementation Plan.
- B. Motion to Adopt StanCOG Social Media Use and Public Outreach Policy
 Kendall Flint described the policy proposed for the use of social media by StanCOG to expand and
 facilitate communication between StanCOG and the public. Member Madrigal asked if Spanish
 language postings would be done. Kendall Flint answered yes.
 - *By Motion (Member Luis Molina/Member Tony Madrigal), and a unanimous vote, the Policy Board adopted the StanCOG Social Media Use and Public Outreach Policy.

Cindy Malekos indicated that a recent amendment to the JPA would alter the term of office to
