PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PLAN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Stanislaus Council of Governments (StanCOG) is proposing a Draft 2015 Public Participation Plan (PPP). The PPP is meant to inform the public and other stakeholders about the overall StanCOG public participation process, how they can receive information from StanCOG, and how they can provide input into regional planning, policy, and decision-making efforts. It sets forth the StanCOG commitment to an open process that provides opportunities for input throughout the decision making continuum.

The Draft 2015 PPP will be released on January 23, 2015 and is available for review at the StanCOG office, located at 1111 I Street, Suite 308, Modesto, California 95354 and on the StanCOG website at www.stancog.org.

A 45-day public review and comment period for the Draft 2015 PPP will commence on Friday, January 23, 2015, and conclude on Monday, March 9, 2015.

StanCOG will hold a public hearing to solicit comments at the regularly scheduled Policy Board meeting on February 18, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. at the StanCOG office building at 1111 I Street, Suite 308, Modesto, California 95354.
