Medivan routes and their fees. Wayne York asked if Medivan would max out at capacity and Angela Swanson informed him that they had room for more occupants. Alternate Member Hayley Vieyra commended the agencies for supporting the community and their riders.

Jean Foletta provided an update on the annual UTN process. She indicated that a draft report would be available on the StanCOG website and taken to the Policy Board in April.

Wayne York shared that ridership was continuing to grow in all modes and demand was continuing to pick up. He also shared that they were preparing for a new operations contract later in the calendar year. He stated that Merced was also going to provide free fares.
