Subject: Approval of Administrative Modification 17 (Type 1 Amendment) to the Stanislaus Council of Government's 2019 FTIP

Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

On November 10, 2011, with the acknowledgement of the StanCOG Policy Board, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) delegated to the StanCOG Executive Director the authority to approve Administrative Modifications to the Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP) and Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). This delegated authority is in accordance with the revised FSTIP/FTIP Amendments and Administrative Modification Procedures dated December 18, 2019.

The Stanislaus Council of Governments' (StanCOG's) Executive Director has completed the review of StanCOG's Administrative Modification 17 to the Federal Fiscal Year 2018/19 - 2021/22 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). This administrative modification does not affect programming capacity that relies on the State's federal programming capacity.

On December 2, 2020, the California Transportation Commission (CTC) adopted the staff recommended 2020 Local Partnership Program (LPP) Competitive Program of Projects. The McHenry Avenue Widening project, located in Stanislaus County, was included in the staff recommendation. StanCOG informed the implementing agency that the awarded funds would be programmed by no later than December 18, 2020. This will ensure that the request for allocation process can continue to move forward and be placed on the CTC agenda for the January 27-28, 2021 meeting. Stanislaus County will be requesting the allocation of STIP and LPP funds in the amount of \$4,860,000 and \$2,128,000, respectfully, for the construction phase of the project.

Administrative Modification 17 updates right of way programming and programs the LPP funds to the construction phase in Federal Fiscal Year 20/21 for the McHenry Avenue Widening project. Programming updates are provided in the attached Summary of Changes presented as Attachment 1, and the modification is consistent with the FSTIP/FTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification Procedures.


